> Aquatic; This program is aimed at Scouts who want to hone their sailing and padding skills. Scouts will have the opportunity to earn the white water merit badge as well as kayaking merit badge while kayaking on the Brule River.

> Scouts will sail catamarans, our 22' Chrysler sail boat, wind surf boards, and then test their skills in regulation sailing regatta on Long Lake. Program fee total is \$433.

> Treks; Scouts participate in a different trek each day. Some treks take place off camp property allowing Scouts to experience outdoor elements not found within the Tomahawk borders. Programs consist of a variety of day long experiences including rock climbing at Taylor's Falls, mountain biking on backcountry trails, whitewater kayaking on Brule River, low and high COPE, an overnight backpacking trip, and more. Program fee total is \$433.
