The Drive to Collect 100,000 Pounds of Food

Scouting for Food is Tecumseh Council's community service project that helps stock the shelves of food pantries in the local area.

Last year, Tecumseh Council collected 89,792 pounds of food that was then donated to area food pantries. These include The Second Harvest Food Bank; Enon Relief; Faith in Christ Lutheran Church; Our Daily Bread in Urban; My Father's Kitchen in Wilmington; Xenia FISH; and Fairborn FISH.

The goal for 2015 is to collect 100,000 pounds of food in the five counties that are in Tecumseh Council. These are Logan, Champaign, Clark, Greene, and Clinton Counties.

We need drivers and vehicles to transport the scouts to and within our assigned location.

Troop 71 will distribute bags on Saturday, March 14, from 9:00 am to around noon. Food pick -up will be on the following Saturday, March 21, again from 9:00 to around noon. Food collected will then be taken back to the Scout Hut to be sorted and counted.

Scouts who participate on either or both Saturdays will receive the appropriate number of service hours.
