Quick Notes from the 10 March 2015 Troop 71 Parents' Meeting

- Scouting for Food. Bag distribution is this Saturday, 14 March 2015. Participants meet at Aley UMC parking lot starting 8:15 am, briefing at 8:30, then head out to designated area. Food collection is Saturday, 21 March 2015. Meet at Aley UMC at 8:15 am.
- Citizenship in the Community Merit Badge. Service project scheduled for two Saturdays, 14 and 21 March 2015, 8 am to 12 pm both days, at the John Ankeney Soccer Complex 505 South Orchard Lane, Beavercreek, Ohio 45434. Meet at the concession stand. Goal is to satisfy requirement number 7.
- Cross-Overs. There were a total of 20 Cub Scouts who crossedover to Troop 71 during the extended weekend of 20-23 February 2015. Possibility of another three will cross-over in the next few weeks. Also, there were three Boy Scouts who transferred to the troop in the past six months.
- Little Miami River Clean-Up. This is on 6 June 2015. Troop 71 will try to sign-up for about a two-mile stretch of Little Miami River near the vicinity of Dayton-Xenia Road and Trebein Road (near Bob Messmore's farm where we camp frequently).
