Hello Camp Tomahawk Scout Parents,

1. In less than two weeks your scouts will be leaving for camp! Attached is the itinerary, to include gear drop off time and early morning show time for departure. We ask that each scout limit their personal gear to 1 duffle bag, backpack or foot locker. For ease of packing the scout trailer, we would prefer a soft-sided bag. On Thursday, 2 Jul 15 we will have a gear drop off and trailer loading at Aley Church to help speed up departure the following morning. Show time for departure is 7:00AM on Friday, 3 Jul 15. All scouts should be wearing their Class A uniform with scarf.
2. Meals will be the responsibility of each scout for the enroute portions of the trip both up and back. We ask that each scout bring a lunch for the first travel day. Each scout should bring money for dinner the first night and lunch the next day. We will provide a light breakfast to include cereal, milk and donuts.
3. Meals for the return trip will also require money for each scout. We will stop for lunch and dinner on 11 Jul 15. Breakfast for the last day, 12 Jul will be provided to include cereal, milk and oatmeal.
4. The trading post at Camp Tomahawk is a popular place for many boys to buy mid-week snacks. So you may want to consider bringing money for that as well.
5. We have attached a map of White Pine Camp, this is the camp we will be staying at while at Camp Tomahawk. We recommend that you print out the map to help the boys locate the merit badge areas the first few days.
6. Parents may want to print off merit badge worksheets and review pre-requisites. In order to completely finish the merit badges with prerequisites, you will need to bring proof of completion of those portions of the merit badge. Camping, Emergency Preparedness, Fish and Wildlife Management, and Personal Fitness are the merit badges with prerequisites and those parents should have already received an email from us on that.
7. We will use Troop 71 tents at the enroute camping locations, so there is no need to pack a tent. Note: We may ask specific older scouts to bring their tents in a separate email. Scout leaders and parents attending scout camp should plan to bring their tent for the enroute stops. All scouts and parents will use the tents provided by Camp Tomahawk while at camp.

8. We believe that the camp fees will cover every aspect of the trip, however, if fuel or other expenses are higher than anticipated we may have to ask for a small increase after camp is over. We don't expect this to occur, but just wanted to give everyone a heads up.



