> Philmont Tune Up September the 19th and 20th
>
> Our first tune up for Philmont will take place on September the 19th and 20th. We will meet at
> Germantown Metro Park near Germantown Ohio. The meeting time is yet to be determined but
it will be
> after lunch. We will hike approx 7 miles each day.
>
> Troop Leaders will be responsible for the Tour Permit and Youth Protection requirements, and
to bring
> Medical Forms.
>
> We will probably meet at the Visitors Center at Germantown Metro Park and start and end our
hike there
> 6910 Boomerahine Road. Then we will go to the campsite. We will meet in the parking lot
>
> We will camp at Camp site number 2 Geronimo at Twin Creek Metro Park. To get to the
campsite go
> south on Route 4 past Germantown. You will cross Twin Creek and go up a good size hill.
When you
> get to the top turn left on Eby Road then turn left on Chamberlain Road then right on
Morningstar Road.
> turn right on the first road into the Park go to the parking lot at the end of the road and the
campsite trail is
> at the end of the parking lot.

> If you have backpacking gear bring it. If you don't DO NOT go buy any. We will be close to
cars and

> your car camping gear will be fine. Get a tent buddy if possible. The idea is for you to look, feel, smell,
> taste, etc. the gear others have to help you make wise choices when you buy your gear. I have wasted a
> lot of money on stuff which I don't use. Learn from my mistakes and the experience of others.
All you
> will need is some kind of pack (a book bag will work). You will need a couple quarts of water, rain gear,
> clothing for the weather, spoon, cup and your regular camping gear. One of the main goals for this
> campout is to talk about backpacking gear.
>
> I will provide the food for this tune up. the cost will be \$7.00. Any leftover money or food will be used
> next time to help reduce the cost. If there are any special diet needs let me know. We will have Saturday
> supper, Sunday breakfast and lunch. All meals will be similar to Philmont meals.
>
> Let me know who is coming so I can plan meals. Please provide emails so I can contact you with the
> latest info.
>
